Student Surveillance Testing

- 1. Rapid antigen test on Sunday, January 30
 - a. Rapid antigen test given to students at school on Friday, January 28.
- 2. PCR test
 - a. OPTION A Tue, or Wed by COVID Testing Today
 - i. One-time registration link -<u>https://book.covid-testing-today.com/?SacredHeartCathedral</u>
 - ii. Tue, 11 am-1 pm, DePaul Campus*
 - iii. Tue, 2:30-4 pm, Lasalle Campus (Seniors and Juniors primarily)
 - iv. Wed, 2:30-4 pm, Lasalle Campus (Sophomores and Frosh primarily)
 - b. OPTION B PCR test on your own

If you have a conflict on one of the days after school, you may test on the other after school day. If you have conflicts with both after school time slots, you may test during lunch on Tuesday.

You will be asked by Ruvna to confirm that you have done all this. Our community-wide effort helps ensure our overall health, safety, and ability to continue in-person learning.

Student Not Fully Vaccinated (or Students in Specific Sports) Testing

- 1. Weekly PCR Test
 - a. Fulfilled by the PCR Test described in #2 for Surveillance Testing.
 - b. Make sure that if you get your PCR test not at SHC, that you submit the result to attendance@shcp.edu (or as directed by your coach) by Friday. This reporting is mandatory for these students and families.
