## **POLO FIELDS - GOLDEN GATE PARK**

## **PLEASE NOTE**

- Students must arrive at the Polo Fields and be seated with their homeroom by 8:30 am. Attendance will be taken.
- Volunteers should check-in at the Polo Fields by 8:30 am.
- Students and volunteers should bring water.
- Students may wear modified dress. It may be cold in the morning so wear a few layers. Wear comfortable shoes; flip flops are not allowed.
- Travel light! Anything brought with you will need to be carried while you walk, so keep that in mind when preparing for the day. No skateboards.
- Students will be dismissed after lunch. We aim to dismiss students between 12:30-1:00 pm.



## **DIRECTIONS**

**From South Bay:** Take Hwy 280 to San Francisco. Take the Brotherhood Way exit and go west (left) on Brotherhood Way. Brotherhood Way ends at Lake Merced Drive. Turn right on Lake Merced Drive. Follow Lake Merced Drive around the lake. Turn right on Sunset Blvd. Continue on Sunset Blvd. until it ends on Middle Drive in Golden Gate Park. Turn left on Middle Drive. Turn right on John F. Kennedy Drive. You will see the Polo Fields on your right (next to the riding stables).

**From North Bay:** Take the Golden Gate Bridge to 19th Ave. exit (Park Presidio Blvd.) through Golden Gate Park to Lincoln Way, right on Lincoln Way to 41st Ave. Right on Martin Luther King Dr. then bear left onto Middle Drive West.

**From East Bay:** Take 80 to SF (Bay Bridge). Take the 9th St. exit towards Civic Ctr./Golden Gate Bridge. Turn Left on Harrison. Turn Right on 9th. Turn Left on Hayes. Turn Left on Gough. Turn Right on Fell. Stay in two left lanes. As Fell splits, when it runs into GG Park, follow the road left. Fell then turns into Lincoln Blvd. Follow Lincoln for about 3 miles. Turn right on 25th (into the park). Turn left at the first stop sign (MLK Dr.). Take right at next stop sign (Middle Dr.). At the next stop sign the entrance to the fields is straight ahead.

**MUNI:** Both the 29 Sunset and the 5 Fulton will bring you close to the Polo Fields.
