

## SHC COVID-19 Vaccination and COVID Testing Policy

### Get Vaccinated

All SHC students and all eligible family members living with SHC students are strongly encouraged to get vaccinated. Families must **upload student vaccination status** through [Magnus](#) when completed. Please only upload vaccination documents to Magnus for those who are fully vaccinated. A person is fully vaccinated if it's been at least 2 weeks since they got the 2nd dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, or one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.

Please visit [this site](#) to learn about and schedule a vaccine appointment. Vaccines are free to people who live, work, or learn in San Francisco. You do not need insurance.

If you are in the process of getting vaccinated, students must provide regular proof of a negative COVID test (PCR) until fully vaccinated.

### Regular COVID-19 Testing is required for any students not fully vaccinated

Students who are *not fully vaccinated* must provide proof of a **negative** COVID-19 test (PCR test) every two weeks beginning the week of August 8. Scheduling, cost and reporting of these regular tests are the responsibility of the family. For any students not fully vaccinated, a COVID test must occur during the week of August 8 with results submitted to [attendance@shcp.edu](mailto:attendance@shcp.edu) by August 13 in order to attend school the week of August 16.

The schedule below are the weeks that we require you to get tested and provide evidence of the negative result to [attendance@shcp.edu](mailto:attendance@shcp.edu).

#### Test week (results due date)

- August 8 (results due by Friday, August 13)
- August 22 (results due by Friday, August 27)
- September 5 (results due by Friday, September 10)
- September 19 (results due by Friday, September 24)
- October 3 (results due by Friday, October 8)
- October 17 (results due by Friday, October 22)
- October 31 (results due by Friday, November 5)

Info for getting tested in San Francisco can be found [here](#), including drop in sites for each day of the week. Please note that vaccinations are currently provided at no cost, with or without insurance coverage, but COVID testing may incur a cost for families. Moreover, SHC will not be providing the COVID testing. It will be the responsibility of any student and their family who is not vaccinated to submit an updated negative COVID test result (PCR test) every two weeks. Again, we highly encourage all students to get vaccinated.
